WOMENS SURVIVORS SUPPORT PROJECT

County: Carmarthenshire

International Women's Day £1000.00

A peer support group for women who have survived domestic abuse. A charity who works very closely with many relevant services, looking to hold an event in Carmarthen Town on International Women's Day in March 2020.

SAUNDERSFOOT YOUTH CLUB

County: Pembrokeshire

Saundersfoot Youth Club £1560.00

A local community Youth project held in the Regency Hall, Saundersfoot for 11-16 year olds from the village and the catchment area (incl approx 8 surrounding villages). To provide more than just a weekly games session to keep them off the streets.
