Purpose: Commissioner Decision – Ref. 456

Title: HQ Solar PV array and Battery Storage Project

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Finance

Executive Summary:

The proposed installation of a Solar PV array and associated battery storage at DPP Headquarters, Llangunnor, Carmarthen is intended to reduce the current headquarters carbon emissions by 149,242 kg/CO² per year.

The current mains grid electrical consumption for the Main Building & FCC combined is 1,277,079 kWh/year. The proposed solar installation will reduce it to 673,1109 kWh/year. This proposed investment in sustainability and decarbonisation is in line with the commitment in the Police and Crime Plan, with the investment in the solar farm specifically referenced as a commitment by the PCC.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the PCC approved the Estate's Department recommendation to award the contract to CBRE for the installation of a new Solar PV array & battery storage at DPP Police Headquarters through the supplier Highland Services. The scope of works also includes civils/ground works, including LV Panel upgrades within the FCC building which are at end of useful life. With the addition of a 15% contingency, the approved scheme expenditure for project stands at £1,692,176.63. The payback period is 12.5 years.
