Title: Community Remedy Options/Menu

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Public Consultation

Executive Summary:

Community Remedy derived from a public consultation in 2012-2013 run by the Home Office. After receiving support from a majority of respondents, the Community Remedy became a key element of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014.

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) for Dyfed-Powys undertook a public consultation during 2013, where a community remedy menu was agreed.

Since 2013, the OPCC in consultation with Dyfed-Powys Police, have updated the community remedy menu regarding internal process revisions aligned to each option; however, the content of the community remedy menu has remained the same since 2013 i.e. 10 years.

Recommendation:

- 1. Undertake necessary consultation on a new community remedy menu.
- 2. Create a dedicated page on the Dyfed-Powys OPCC website.
- 3. Publish the outcome of the public consultation on the dedicated website page.
- 4. Create an official document outlining a list of potential remedy options, as agreed as a result of consultation.
