<p>The criteria contained within this Role Specification will form the basis for shortlisting suitable applicants to become a Youth Ambassador. These criteria are the necessary requirements to enable an effective performance within the role.</p>	
<b>Criterion</b>	<b>Competency</b>
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be between 14 - 25 years of age;</li> <li>Must live in the Dyfed-Powys area (Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion, Pembrokeshire or Powys).</li> </ul>
Working with people	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Able to demonstrate the ability to work as part of a team;</li> <li>Contribute views, suggestions and ideas.</li> <li>Able to engage with others (for example, peers, school, college, youth group or service, local community and communicating findings to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner).</li> </ul>
Effective communication skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Comfortable talking to and working with other young people and adults.</li> <li>Able to demonstrate the ability to make a reliable contribution on behalf of the community.</li> </ul>
Motivation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ability to demonstrate enthusiasm for improving the service user's experience.</li> <li>Ability to attend the core meetings a within a year.</li> </ul>
Respect for people	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Commitment to treat all people fairly and with respect, to value diversity and respond sensitively to difference;</li> <li>Demonstrates the ability to be open to new ideas and methods of working.</li> </ul>
