**Title: DPP2512 High Risk DA Perpetrator Support**

**Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Finance**

### **Executive Summary:**

Following the announcement of a £53 million investment in rolling-out The Drive Project across England and Wales over the next four years, the Home Office intends to provide funding for the initial mobilisation and delivery of The Drive Project for the financial years 2025-2026 and 2026-27.

The Drive Project is a response to domestic abuse that aims to reduce the number of child and adult victims of domestic abuse by disrupting and changing perpetrator behaviour. The Drive Project focuses on priority high-risk or serial perpetrators, both male and female, aged 16 and over.

### **Recommendation:**

The contract for the provision of High-Risk Domestic Abuse Perpetrator Support (DRIVE Programme) is awarded to Threshold DAS for a period of one (1) year, with one (1) annual extension period subject to agreed funding.

The total cost for the provision for the initial one (1) year period is £282,411.24.
