The criteria contained within this Role Specification will form the basis for shortlisting suitable applicants to become a Youth Ambassador. These criteria are the necessary requirements to enable an effective performance within the role.	
Criterion	Competency
Eligibility	- Must be between 16 - 25 years of age; - Must live in the Dyfed-Powys area (Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion, Pembrokeshire or Powys).
Working with people	- Able to demonstrate the ability to work as part of a team; - Contribute views, suggestions and ideas. - Able to engage with others (for example, peers, school, college, youth group or service, local community and communicating findings to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner).
Effective communication skills	- Comfortable talking to and working with other young people and adults. - Able to demonstrate the ability to make a reliable contribution on behalf of the community.
Motivation	- Ability to demonstrate enthusiasm for improving the service user's experience. - Ability to attend the core meetings a within a year.
Respect for people	- Commitment to treat all people fairly and with respect, to value diversity and respond sensitively to difference; - Demonstrates the ability to be open to new ideas and methods of working.
