DYFED-POWYS LOCAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE DELIVERY PLAN OVERVIEW 2024-2025

'TACKLING VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN, DOMESTIC ABUSE AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE' AND 'CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE' ARE TWO GOLDEN THREADS ACROSS ALL PRIORITIES

Priority 1 - Victims and Witnesses

- 1. Compliance with the Victims' Code improving the experience for all victims across the Criminal Justice System.
- 2. Reduce domestic abuse attrition Progress action plan from DA Attrition workshop
- 3. Monitor RASSO performance, including data analysis and Op Soteria updates.
- 4. Focus on Family Court ensuring support for victims and alignment with criminal justice.

Priority 2 - People who have offended

- 1. Offender housing/accommodation needs. Carmarthen housing to be progressed.
- 2. IOM Roll out the successful IOM housing pilot across Dyfed-Powys.
- 3. Support the work of the PWO Taskforce.
- 4. Whole System Approach Women's Centre in Carmarthen to be opened.
- 5. Restorative Justice offer to be explored.
- 6. Perpetrators of VAWDASV Updates on provisions to be provided to board.
- 7. Women's Blueprint receive and share updates, including data. Test/Review psychologically, gender and trauma informed model.

RACE – Incorporated into both priorities

- 1. Receive updates and requests for info/action from sub-groups
 - 2. Identify lived experience case studies
- 3. Consider opportunities to pilot aspects of the Wales wide projects at a local level
