NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN UNDER Sections 29, 30 and 31 of the Public Audit (Wales) Act 2004:

- 1. From 17th June 2019 to 12th July 2019 inclusive between 10.00a.m. and 4.00p.m. Mondays to Fridays any person interested, on application to the Chief of Staff, may inspect and make copies of the accounts of the above named organisations for the year ended 31 March 2019 and all the books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts at the Police Headquarters.
- 2 On or after 15th July 2019 at 09.00 a.m. the Auditor General, Mr Adrian Crompton, 24 Cathedral Road, Cardiff, CF11 9LJ, at the request of any local government elector for the area to which the accounts relate will give an opportunity to ask questions about the accounts and any such elector or his/her representative may attend before the Auditor at the said Police Headquarters and make any objection to any of the accounts.
- 3. No objection may be made on behalf of the elector unless the Auditor General has previously received notice in writing of the proposed objection and of the grounds on which objection is made. A copy of said notice shall be sent to the undersigned at the given address.
