This report sets out the findings of the Police and Crime Commissioner's Select Committee review into crime and anti-social behaviour (ASB) intervention, prevention, and engagement services for young adults aged 18-25.

Recommendations linked to areas for improvement have been shared with partners.

The impact of police prevention activity must be demonstrated to young adults



Local authorities should publish information on intervention services



PCC to instigate discussions regarding a formal governance structure



Ensure a focus on social & emotional skills and healthy relationships in services



Police to consider development of a Strategic Profile for 18-25 year olds



Police data dashboards to be updated to include age group information



POP Plans scrutiny to assess the effectiveness of mental health services



Police to seek assurance that Outcome 22 is being utilised effectively



Evaluation learning to be shared between local authority areas



Child Centred Policing Analyst to measure impact of services



Police Trainer to work with partners to deliver training to ensure awareness of services available



Partners should actively promote services for 18-25 year olds
